Things to note:

1. Application forms:

A. can be obtained from the School Office, OR

B. can be downloaded from our school website (www.scc.edu.hk).

You may fill in the form either in Chinese or English.

- 2. Completed application forms have to be submitted to the School Office, or via the SSPA e-Platform on/before 16th January, 2026 together with the following documents:
 - A. the Form One SSPA Discretionary Places Application Form issued by Education Bureau
 - B. photocopies of Primary 5 report card and Primary 6 First Term report card
 - C. photocopy of identity card
 - D. photocopies of proof of achievements in areas other than academic studies (Note: Testimonial is **not** required)
- 3. All applicants will have to attend an interview. The dates of the interview are 16th and 17th March, 2026.

Applicants may refer to the date and time for the interview on our school website (<u>www.scc.edu.hk</u>) after 10th February, 2026, or visit our school office during office hours.

- 4. Quota for SSPA Discretionary Places: 40
- 5. Criteria for selection:

Academic results and Rank Order List by Education Bureau	50%
Extra-curricular activities, service and conduct	15%
Performance in interviews	35% *

English: 20% Cantonese: Chinese Language – 10%, Thinking Skills – 5%

6. Notification arrangements for Successful List for Discretionary Places

Our school will notify parents of successful applicants of their children's inclusion in the Successful List for Discretionary Places by postal mail and phone on 31st March, 2026. These notification arrangements are not applicable to reserve and unsuccessful applicants, nor are the notifications of the allocation results. The parents concerned do not need to reply to the notifications.

7. Release of results

The result of Discretionary Place will be released on 7th July, 2026, together with the result of Central Allocation. Applicants need not contact our school for the results.

Our school has no affiliation with any primary schools. We welcome all primary six students to apply for our F.1 places.
